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## CLASS OFFERINGS

### **Supernovas: Parent & Me (Ages 18 months – 2 years)**

These fun classes explore the fundamentals of gymnastics movement and strengthening through basic tumbling skills, games and music. Parents (or caretakers) learn how to properly hold, spot and assist their child in a variety of exciting tumbling, balance and agility skills on the bars, balance beam, floor, trampoline and vault.

### **Tumble Stars (Ages 3 – 5)**

Students learn gymnastics foundations through strength skills, flexibility skills, obstacle courses and by utilizing several apparatus such as bars, balance beam, vault, floor and trampoline. This class prepares students for our Mini Acro Stars classes, leading into our acrobatics program. Tumbling Stars build skills in the areas of balance, strength, agility, and flexibility.

### **Mini Acro Stars (Ages 5 – 7)**

This class prepares students to enter our acrobatics program by providing the fundamentals for acrobatic movement and tumbling. Students will focus primarily on floor and trampoline with occasional skills taught on bars, balance beam and vault centered on strength, coordination and balance. Additionally, this class teaches gymnastics fundamentals and technique. Students who successfully complete all Mini Acro Stars skills (approximately 1 – 3 years of training) will have the opportunity to continue on to Acro Stars (see description below) or may enter into the PAAM School acrobatics program (intermediate – advanced classes) upon completion.

### **Acro Stars (Ages 7 – 10)**

An acrobatics only focus, students learn how to properly develop acrobatic and gymnastics skills with an emphasis on balance, strength and flexibility. Unlike a traditional gymnastics class, acro does not employ the use of large apparatus, such as balance beam and bars. Most work is done on mats, with various props and apparatus used to build strength, agility and coordination. Upon completion of all skills required at the Acro Stars level, students are encouraged to enter into the PAAM School acrobatics program.

## GYM INFORMATION & POLICIES

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Please call (415) 843-1619 or email [acro@paamarts.com](mailto:acro@paamarts.com) if you are going to be absent.
- Students may bring a water bottle to class. A filtered FloWater station is on-site, but not a water fountain to drink from directly. Water bottles must have a top to prevent spilling. Open containers are not allowed on the gym floor.
- Cubbies are available in the lobby to store personal items during class. TumbleSpot is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Street shoes are not allowed on the gym floor. Shoes must be removed before entering class.
- Only enrolled students are allowed on the gym floor, and only during their scheduled class. Parents, guardians and other non-enrolled family members must remain in the lobby.
- All classes, with the exception of Supernovas, are drop-off. Parents/guardians are welcome to wait in the lobby. Pick-up is promptly when class ends.
- If your child cannot use the restroom alone, please remain on-site during their scheduled class.
- TumbleSpot is not responsible for supervising students before or after their scheduled class. Students must be dropped-off and picked-up precisely on time.
- Studio equipment must not be touched without the direct supervision and instruction of a TumbleSpot employee. Any equipment damaged due to unauthorized use will be billed to the client.

### **DRESS CODE**

Bare feet and clothes you can move easily in. A leotard may be worn if desired. Hair must be secured back. For safety reasons, students may not wear skirts, dresses, loose/baggy clothing or jewelry.

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## **DROP-INS**

Students are welcome to drop-in for one trial class. A \$25 drop-in fee and completed online profile (including agreement to policies) through our database is required before your trial class begins. The \$25 drop-in fee is applied to your first month's membership dues should you choose to enroll in the class. Drop-ins are subject to class availability and must be age appropriate. Please contact us in advance for class availability.

## **CLASS MAKEUPS**

Each student is allowed one makeup per month. Makeup classes must be scheduled in advance and redeemed within 30 days of the absence. Prorated tuition or refund is not offered for missed classes.

## **PRIVATE LESSONS**

- Payment is due prior to the scheduled lesson.
- No refunds are given for any reason once lessons are scheduled, confirmed and paid for.
- To cancel a scheduled lesson, notice must be received a minimum of 24 hours in advance to ensure a make-up lesson. Make-up lessons are scheduled at the discretion of the instructor.
- Unscheduled, purchased lessons do not expire. Once a lesson is scheduled and confirmed it is the responsibility of the client to know their schedule.
- There are no make-up lessons given for lessons cancelled within 24 hours of the scheduled time for any reason.
- If the teacher is unable to give a scheduled lesson, a make-up lesson will be scheduled.
- Lessons will start at their scheduled time. If a student is tardy, the time will not be made up. Tardiness in excess of 10 minutes will result in a cancelled lesson. The lesson fees will not be refunded and there will be no make-up lesson scheduled.

## **BIRTHDAY PARTIES**

- A \$150 non-refundable deposit is due upon booking to reserve party date and time. Remaining balance is due 16 days prior to party. No refunds of remaining balance are offered for any reason within 16 days of the party date.
- All parties are held at TumbleSpot, 750 Redwood Hwy, Suite 1212, Mill Valley, CA 94941.
- An accurate head count (including birthday girl/boy) is required one week prior to the booked date to ensure appropriate instructor coverage. Parties exceeding the maximum number of guests stated in their contract will be charged an additional fee.
- Family may arrive for set up at the studio no more than 15 minutes prior to start time. You may arrange for earlier set up for an additional \$20 per extra 15 minutes.
- 15 minutes is allotted following the end of the party for clean up. Parties that go over this allotment will be charged \$20 per each 15 minute interval exceeded.
- Parties are restricted to the use of ONE gym studio, lobby and restrooms. Guests must remain in the lobby and may not enter the gym floor without permission from the instructor.
- Parents are responsible for supervising all party guests when they are not under instructor supervision. Guests are not allowed on the gym floor without an instructor present.
- TumbleSpot will provide ONE six-foot table with benches and/or folding chairs for the party.
- 15-20 minutes of party time is reserved for cake/pizza, etc. Parents are responsible for providing all food, paper goods, decorations, matches, and utensils.
- Parents are responsible for clean up of all items brought to the studio for the party.

## **WAIVER & RELEASE**

- While TumbleSpot endeavors to take reasonable and appropriate safety precautions, participation in supervised lessons involve some risk of injury. Clients release and hold harmless TumbleSpot and all of its principals, agents, contractors, and employees of and from any actions, claims, and damages of any kind, on account of injuries of any type or nature incurred in connection with their child's or personal participation. In case of emergency, students may be treated by a qualified physician. TumbleSpot does not assume responsibility for any injury or damage which might arise out of or in connection with such authorized emergency medical treatment.

- TumbleSpot may use your child's photo to appear in promotional and educational material without identification. TumbleSpot uses social media outlets (Facebook/Instagram) that allow comments and "tagging" by users. TumbleSpot is held harmless for any user comments or user "tagging" identifying your child. Upon written request, TumbleSpot will remove any comments or tagging identifying your child.
- TumbleSpot does not tolerate any of the following and any child, or his/ her parent, family or friend, engaging in any of the following will result in the child's dismissal, without refund: Physical aggression towards any other person; refusal to participate; inability to pay attention or focus; disruptive behavior; verbally abusive or threatening towards any other person; inability to stay in gym studio without parent; causes harm, or threatens to cause harm, to self, others or property of TumbleSpot or another; intentionally exposes a sick or contagious child or self to others; throws objects; takes or hides other's belongings; violence; vandalism; threatening behavior (physical or emotional); sexual misconduct.
